



## Waterford LGFA 1<sup>st</sup> Year Championship

### Competition Structure

- The teams will be split into two groups West and East.
- Each team will play each other in the group section.
- Every team will have one home game and one away game.
- The teams that finish top of their respective groups will qualify for the Division 1 Final.
- The teams that finish 2nd in each group will qualify for the Division 2 Final.
- The teams that finish 3rd in each group will qualify for the Division 3 Final.
- If two or more teams finish on level points in the group, score difference will decide the group standings. If the scoring difference is the same, it will go on the head to head result.

### Fixtures

- The first team named in the fixtures will have home advantage.
- It is the home team's responsibility to host the game.
- If the school does not have adequate facilities to host the game, it is their responsibility to contact a local club for the use of their facilities/grounds.
- It is the responsibility of BOTH schools to make contact with relevant opponent and play as per schedule to avoid fixtures back up and to arrange time, venue and date. When these are decided please email the date and time of the game to the email below in advance of the game.
- It is both schools' responsibility to contact the email below with the results of the game. Results must be received by 5pm on the date stated on the fixtures.
- Failure to fulfill your fixture will result in your team getting 0 points and the win being awarded to the opposition.

### Match Rules

- Matches will be 25 minutes per half.
- The games will be 15 aside on a full-size pitch.
- Each team will have UNLIMITED subs.
- The winning team will receive 2 points. In the event of a draw each team will receive 1 point.

### Referee

- A team sheet with the list of ALL players names (with their numbers) should be given to the referee before the match (for insurance purposes).
- It is the HOME team's responsibility to contact a referee and they must be picked from the Waterford Ladies Referees approved list ONLY.
- If the school is having trouble getting a referee, please contact us and we can help.
- Both schools will contribute 20 euro each to the referee's fee.
